 other part, witnesseth that the said Burj Davis
 and Martha his wife for and in consideration
 of the sum of five hundred Dollars to them
 in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereunto at-
 tested and have hereunder, sold and conveyed
 and by these presents do bargain sell and con-
 vey unto him the said Edmund King the East
 half of the South east quarter of section five
 in Township twenty four of Range twelve
 East containing sixty two acres & $\frac{23}{100}$ of an
 acre, lying in the said County of Shelby in
 the Land district of Tuscumbia to have and to
 hold together with all and singular the rights
 privileges and immunities and appurtenances
 to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining
 unto him the said Edmund King, his heirs
 executors, administrators and assigns from
 them the said Burj Davis and his wife
 Martha, their heirs, executors, administra-
 tors and assigns, and from all and every per-
 son, whatsoever, with warrant or cause defused
 in fee simple. In witness whereof the said
 Burj Davis and Martha his wife have
 hereunto set their hands and affixed their
 seals in common form on the day and year
 written.
