Commissioners Court to me directed to lay off  
Jail Bounds fifteen acres, of land which shall be the Prison  
Bounds for said County which said includes  
the ten acres on which the town of Columbia  
was so built with the boundaries of said  
ten acres, with the addition of five acres  
commencing at the Point West corner of said  
ten acres running South 4° E marked on

a white oak, hickory or white oak 10 poles to a  
stake there N  $4^{\circ} 5'$  marked on a white oak  
hickory & sweet gum 29 poles to a stake in  
the branch below the spring stem N.  $8^{\circ} 0'$   
marked on a white oak, pine & black gum  
29 poles to a stake there E  $4^{\circ} 5^{\prime \prime}$  marked on  
black oak, white oak & white oak 29 poles to a  
stake on the west boundary line of the said  
town of Columbia April 27<sup>th</sup> 1829.
