 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 twenty, between Thomas H. Brasher of Shelby
 County and State of Alabama on the part
 and Argulus Henderson of said county and
 State of the other part, witnesseth that
 Thos. H. Brasher for and in consideration of
 the sum of two hundred and sixty Dollars to him
 in hand paid by the said Argulus Henderson
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 parts bargained and sold and by other parts due
 bargin and sell unto the said Argulus Henderson
 and to his heirs & assigns forever all that he tract
 or parcel of land lying the South West quarter of section
 eleven, in township twenty one, of range one east
 in the District of Tuscaloosa in the County of Shelby
 and State of Alabama containing one hundred
 and fifty acres and fifty one hundredths of an acre
 to gotten with all and singular heretofore retained
 and appertaining thereto belonging or in any
 wise appertaining and also are the estate right
 title and claim to demand whatever is herein the
 said Thos. H. Brasher either in law or in equity
 and to the above bargained premises and
 every part and parcel thereof to have and to
 hold the said lands, tenements and herediti-
 ments, and all and singular the premises here-
 inbefore mentioned with their appurtenances
 unto the said Argulus Henderson his heirs and
 assigns and to his and their only proper use
 and benefit free from the claim or claims of
 all persons whatsoever claiming under, through or
 by me and from all other persons. In witness

 ubilited his name, and affixed his seal the
 day and date first above written
 signed, sealed and delivered Thos. H. Brasher Seal
