of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty
six between John Wallace of the County of Shelby
and State of Alabama of the one part and Clayton
Thompson of the State of Alabama of the County of
Jefferson of the other part witnesseth that the said
John Wallace for and in consideration of the sum
of fifty five dollars to me in hand paid the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have the
day Benjamin sold all and sufficed & conve

and by these presents doth bargain, sell, alien or
 convey unto the said Clayton Thompson
 all that certain tract or parcel of land being
 and lying in the State & County aforesaid &
 being the half of the North East half of the
 thirtieth section, resilienth township first range
 East of the basis meridian containing forty
 acres be the same more or less said land to
 but and bound on the line dividing it from
 with sections from the North corner at the
 said twenty miles and thirtieth section
 south ward to the half mile stone or the same
 and running north west and south west for
 compliment to have and to hold the above
 described half of the half quarter of land and
 bargained premises with the several cuts
 and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
 wise appertaining unto the said Clayton
 Thompson to him and his heirs & assigns
 forever. And the said John Wallace for himself
 his heirs executors, and administrators doth
 warrant and will forever defend the title to
 the above described and heretofore granted premises
 unto the said Clayton Thompson to him
 and his heirs & assigns forever from and against
 myself my heirs, executors and assigns and all
 and every person or persons claiming or holding
 under him the said John Wallace, and also
 against the lawful title, claim or demand of all
 and every person or persons whosoever claiming
 or holding by, from or under the Government of
