lands of the County of Shelby and State of  
Alabama have this day given and bequeathed  
unto my daughter her and her bodily heirs  
forever a certain Negro girl named Patterson  
about twelve years of age, which said Negro  
girl I warrant her and her issue unto the  
said Charlotte G. Evans and her bodily heirs  
forever to be and to stand good and sufficient  
either in law and equity I further warrant  
her the said Negro & issue clear from me and  
the rest of my heirs and all other persons  
living under my hand and seal this the  
fourteenth day of November, 1839.
