I day of October one thousand eight hundred and
ninety eight between Thos. R. Brasher of the State
Levi Weaver of Alabama, and Shelly County of the first part
Page 28. and Levi Weaver of the said State & county of the
second part, witness, that I the said Thos. R.
Brasher for and in consideration of the sum of
one hundred and twenty four dollars to me in
hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged, I doth grant, bargained and sold and by
these presents doth grant, bargain & sell unto
Levi Weaver his heirs & assigns a certain piece of land

lyng and living in the State of Alabama
Shelby County, and bounded as follows to wit:-
the East half of the North East quarter or section
thirty six, in township twenty range one East,
in the district of lands offered for sale at Tuscaloosa,
containing nearly eight acres and nearly four
hundredths of an acre together with all and
singular the improvements, hereditaments and
appurtenances, thereunto belonging or in anywise app-
pertaining for the only proper use benefit and
behalf of him the said Lewis Weare his heirs
executors and administrators or assigns and I do
and Thomas R. Brasher do hereby bind myself
my heirs, executors or administrators to warrant &
forever defend the above described premises, unto the
above named Lewis Weare, his heirs executors
administrators or assigns forever, against myself
my heirs, executors or administrators and all other
person or persons, claiming the same or any part
thereof, as also from the General Government of
the United States of America.
