

Brasher H. L. This indenture made the third day of February in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty between Henry L. Brasher of the
 State of Alabama and County of Shelby of the
 first part and Ambrose Dallan of the State &
 County aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth:
 That the said party of the first part for and in consider-
 ation of the sum of two hundred dollars is him in
 hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged both bargained &
 sold and by these presents do bargain & sell unto the
 said party of the first part and his heirs & assigns forever
 one undivided tract or parcel of land being the
 east tract of the south west quarter of section ten
 in township twenty one of range one East in the
 District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama
 containing eighty acres and twenty six hundred rods
 of an acre together with all and singular the
 hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging
 or in any way appertaining and also all
 the estate right title, interest claims & demand
 whatsoever of him the said party of the first part
 either in law or in equity of him and to the
 above bargained premises, and every tract and
 parcel thereof he have and to hold to the said
 party of the second part his heirs & assigns
 to the sole and only proper use and behove
 of the said party of the second part, his heirs and
 assigns forever, and the said party of the first
 part doth hereby warrant and defend the
 title of the above described land free from all
 claims whatever to the said party of the second
 part. In witness whereof the said party of the
 first part hath hereunto set his name and affix-
 ed his seal the day & date above written
 Signed sealed & delivered in presence of Henry L. Brasher
 Ambrose Dallan } Personally appeared before
 The State of Alabama } me Leonard Tarrant

 of said County, Henry L. Brasher who acknowledged

our Lord 1830.

for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars
to me in hand paid by the above named Ambrose
Dallen do hereby relinquish all my right title
dower and interest of Dover sis and to be within
divided tract or parcel of land to the said Ambrose
Dallen his heirs & assigns forever as witness my
hand and seal this 3d day of February in die year
of our Lord 1830.
