This Indenture made and entered into in the year 1829 between Edmund King and Jack Bleakleford executors of Job Warren dec'd, of the one part and Samuel Pledger of the other part, all of the County of Shelby Alabama Wilmot & that wheres and on the 18 day of March in the year of our said Lord and King or one of the executors of Job Warren having been previously authorized by the Court of Ordinary and having advertised according to law did make and seal this 18th day of March 1829 at the residence of the said Job Warren dec'd offer for sale at public auction the West half of the South West quarter of section twenty-one township 18 of range one west, containing nearly nine and 93/100 of an acre together with a part of the East half of the South West quarter of the same section being all that part of the last mentioned half quarter section that lies the West side of the State road the quantity unknown.

And the said Pledger being the highest bidder at the price of one hundred and ninety one Dollars twenty five cents and having complied with the terms of the said sale, the said executors doth hereby sell & convey and by these presents doth warrant sell and convey unto him the said Pledger all those right title vizt.

and claim to the before mentioned tract of
land of which the said Job Warren did
not possess or intend to at the time of his
death together with all and singular the
appurtenances to the same belonging or in any
wise appertaining to have, and to hold
unto him in the said Deed for his heirs &
