 unto Gabriel Moore Governor of the State of Ala-  
 bama, & his successor in office in the sum  
 of twenty five hundred dollars well and truly  
 to be made we bind our selves our and each  
 of our heirs, exors & administrators & finally  
 by these presents, signed & sealed with our seals  
 this 15 day of February, 1830. The condition of  
 the above obligation is such that whereas the  
 above bound David Durin has been duly  
 elected assessor and tax collector for Shelby  
 County for the year 1830, now if the said  
 David Durin shall well and truly discharge  
 the duties of said office agreeable to law then  
 the above obligation shall be void the same  
 in full force & effect.
