 South East fourth of section twenty six township
 twenty range one east, in the district of Tuscaloosa
 and State of Alabama containing nearly nine
 acres more or less, now known as that in consider-
 ation of the premises I Thos. M^r Adams have
 bargained, granted, and by these presents do give
 and grant unto the said Hiram Brasher the above
 described land to have and to hold the same together
 with all the rights, privileges, immunities and ap-
 purtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging
 and I do bind myself, my heirs, executors, adminis-
 trators and assigns to warrant and forever defend
 unto the said Hiram Brasher his heirs and
 assigns the above described land. In testimony

 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty
