To all to whom these presents shall come I
 Jacob D. Shelby Sheriff of Shelby County
 send greeting Whereas by a writ of execution
 return issued out of the circuit Court of
 Shelby County Alabama to me directed and

and defined, dated the 24th day of Mar 1830
 I was commanded to make of the goods and
 chattels of N. Bennett in my county the sum of
 five hundred dollar damages and one hundred
 and eighty one dollars and 75³/₄ cents costs
 which John Honeycutt, and Nancy Honeycutt
 his wife have recovered against him in said
 court for their damages which they had sus-
 tained by reason of the speaking & publishing
 certain slanderous words of and concerning said
 Honey as for their costs and charges and if
 sufficient goods - chattels could not be found then
 I should cause the said damages to be made
 of the lands and tenements whereof the said N. Ben-
 nett was seized on the 27th day of April in the
 year 1830 or at any time afterwards in whose
 hands soever the same might be unless the
 said writ of execution upon reference being
 thereunto had will more fully appear and
 whereas after the coming of said writ to me and
 before the day of the return thereof I did by vir-
 tue of the said writ serve and take the lands
 hereinafter particularly described and have for want
 of goods & chattels in my county of the said
 Bennett to satisfy the said damages and the
 said lands as hereinafter mentioned at public
 sale according to the Statute in such cases
 made and provided to Joshua B. H. Sawyer
 for two hundred and one Dollars being the highest
 sum bid for the same. Know ye that I gave
 D. Shelly the Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the
 said writ of execution and of the Statute in
 such cases made and provided in considera-
 tion of the said sum of Two hundred and
 one dollar to me in hand paid by the said
 Joshua B. H. Sawyer the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have granted bargained
 and sold, and by their presents to grant
 bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 Joshua B. H. Sawyer to his heirs and assigns
 forever all that certain parcel of land lying
 and being in the town of Colerain in a town
 and designated in the plan of said town
 as Lots number 3, 4, 5 & 6 with their appur-
 tenances and all the estate right title &
 interest which the said N. Bennett had in

in said tract, give or haul of land on the
 27th day of April 1830 or at any time
 since had or now hath, to have and to hold
 the said lands and premises and every part
 thereof with the appurtenances unto the
 said Joshua B. No. Sander his heirs and as-
 signs forever as fully and absolutely as if the
 said Jacob D. Shelly as Sheriff aforesaid and
 under the authority aforesaid might could
 or ought to sell and convey the same.
