in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty six between Jackson B. Hale
of the County of Shreve and State of Alabama of
the first part and Thomas H. Brader of the County
and State aforesaid of the second part witnesseth
that the said party of the first part for and in
consideration of the sum of eight hundred
Dollars to him in hand paid by the said party
of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged and shall be accounted and paid by
these presents doth bargained and sold and by
the said party of the second part and to his heirs
and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of
land wherein the said party of the first part now

now lies being south East quarter of pre-
mises of Sections thirty one of lower slip
miles of Range three East in the district
of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama containing
one hundred & forty acres, also the west half
of the north West quarter of fractional section
thirty one and lower slip number or Range
three East in the district of Tuscaloosa and State
of Alabama containing eighty acres together
with all and singular the hereditaments and
appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise
appertaining and also all the right
title, interest and claim and demand whatsoever
of him the said party of the first part
either in law or in equity of his and to
the above bargained premises, and every part
and parcel thereof to have and to hold to the
said party of the second part his heirs and
assigns to the sole and only use and
benefit and behoof of the said party of the
second part his heirs & assigns forever.
