consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars  
lawful money to me in hand paid by John Lolley  
of the County and State aforesaid the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted  
bargained and sold and by these presents do  
grant bargain and sell unto the said John  
Lolley his heirs and assigns a certain tract

of land lying and being in said County  
 it being the West half of the South west  
 quarter, or certain twenty eight hundred  
 twenty one or more acres situated in the district  
 of Tuscaloosa containing twenty nine acres,  
 and twenty eight hundredths of an acre  
 convey'd by patent to said James Walker  
 and recorded in the Land Office in 172  
 Pay 420 dollars with all the appendi-  
 cums, fixtures belonging, and all the estate  
 right titles and interest, claim and de-  
 mand whatsoever of him the said James  
 Walker of me and to the said tract of land  
 and premises, and every part and parcel  
 thereof to have and to hold the said tract  
 of land and premises and all and singular  
 other the premises above mentioned and  
 every part and parcel thereof with the  
 appendicums unto the said John Lolly  
 his heirs and assigns to the sole proper-  
 ty and benefit of the said John Lolly  
 his heirs and assigns forever and the  
 said James Walker for himself and his  
 heirs the said tract of land and premises  
 and any part thereof against him and  
 his heirs and against all and every other  
 person or persons whomsoever to the said  
 John Lolly his heirs and assigns shall  
 and will warrant and forever defend by  
 these presents on witness whereof I have  
 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal  
 this 22<sup>d</sup> day of January 18<sup>21</sup>.

 land it shall be fully relinquished to the  
 said John Lolly his heirs & assigns
