 tress, estate & claim and demand both at law
 and in equity and as well in possession as in
 expectancy, or recovery of me and to all that certain
 tract or parcel or parcels of land lying and situated
 in the said County of Shelly and known and
 designated by the Writ'st $\frac{1}{4}$ of section No. 6 Township
 22 Range 2 west also the $\frac{1}{4}$ of section No. 6 of sec-
 tion 22 Range 2 west, Also the $\frac{1}{4}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of section
 No. 1 Township 22 Range 3 west. It being the same
 farm of which Richard Grosvenor was seized at the
 time of his death all and singular the hereditaments
 and appurtenances therunto belonging.
