This indenture made this twenty ninth day
of May in the year eighteen hundred and
twenty four between Edmond King of the one
part, and William Pitts of the other part both
of Shelby County, State of Missouri, Witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of
three hundred dollars to me in hand paid
by the said Pitts the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged both bargained, sold and con-
veyed and by their parents do bargain, sell
and convey unto the said Pitts all that tract
or parcel of land lying in the County and
State aforesaid and designated according to
the official plat of the survey of the said
lands of the United States by the route
East quarter of section thirty three township
twenty one range thirty west which was
purchased by said King of the United States
and granted to said King. Now know ye
that the Edmond King for myself my
heirs assigns in consideration of the
foregoing do hereby sell convey and confirm
unto the said William Pitts the said tract
of land to have and to hold the same

Together with all the rights, privileges and immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Mrs. Pitts his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Edmund King for myself my heirs & assigns do warrant the said tract of land unto the said William Pitts against my heirs and assigns and against all other persons claiming under my name, In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal the day and date above written, Edmund King Real

But it seems to be heard that Nancy King wife of the within named Edmund King came this day in her own proper person and upon examination separate and apart from her said husband declares that she relinquishes all her right or claim or right of dower to the within divided tract of land to the within named William Pitts from hereforth and forever. In witness whereof she hereunto subscribed her name and affixed her seal in common form on the 1st day of January 1829 Nancy King.

Before us Daniel E. Nations & Mr. C. Buckley two of the Justices of the Peace for said County personally appeared Edmund King and acknowledged he executed the within deed for the purpose therein mentioned and Nancy King the wife of the said Edmund King acknowledged that she executed the above relinquishment of dower fully and without any constraint or compulsion from her said husband.
