Lass. of the first part and Edmund King of the second part, Witnesseth: that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to him in hand paid at and before the making and delivering of these presents, by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, that tract or parcel of land known as designated as the North East quarter of section five in township twenty four of range twelve East situated lying and being in the district of Lands offered for sale at the Land office in Tuscaloosa in the State of Alabama, together with all and singular tenements, and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the revenues and reversions, remainders and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate right title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever of him the said party of the first part either in law or in equity of in and to the above bargained premises and every part and parcel thereof, To have and to hold to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns to the sole and only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators doth hereby warrant and will forever defend the title of the above bargained premises to the said Edmund King his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of all and every person or persons, whatsoever, as also from the claim of the great Government.
