

Bullard A. This Indenture made this twelfth day of July  
 in the year eighteen hundred and twenty seven  
 between Allen Bullard of the County of Shelby  
 and State of Alabama, of the one part, and James  
 Bullard of the other part witnesseth that for and in  
 consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars to  
 him in hand paid by the said James Bullard  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath  
 this day bargained, sold and conveyed unto the  
 said James Bullard, all that piece, parcel or tract  
 of land lying and being in the County and  
 State aforesaid being the West half of the North East  
 quarter, of section two of township twenty one of  
 Range three West, in the district of Tuscaloosa  
 and State of Alabama, containing nearly nine  
 acres, and seventy four hundredths of an acre  
 according to the official plat of the Survey of the  
 land returned to the General Land office by  
 the Surveyor General to have and to hold the said  
 tract of land with all and singular the tenement  
 & hereditaments unto the James Bullard his heirs  
 executors &c, forever, and the said Allen Bullard  
 for himself his heirs, done warrant and will  
 forever defend the title to the hereby granted premises  
 to the said James Bullard against the lawful  
 title, claim or demand of any person or  
 persons, claiming under, by or from the Gov-  
 ernment of the United States.
