Wear, to said John Carroll and said Dudley
Randall with all the appurtenances be-
longing or appertaining to same to be sold
to the said tract or parcel of land and

premises unto the said Dudley Randall all his heirs
and assigns forever, and I do hereby warrant and
agree with the said Dudley Randall all his heirs and
assigns forever, that he may, shall and will enjoy
& possess, the said land and premises free from all
incumbrance whatever, of myself my heirs
executors or assigns hereby warranting the same
unto the said Dudley Randall and from defendant
the same by these presents, in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 17th day
of June, 1831.
