 March 20th 1832, know all men by these
 presents that Thomas H. Brasher has this day
 bargained and sold and do by these presents
 bargain and sell unto Thomas P. Hawkins
 a certain negro slave to wit: one woman black
 about thirty six years old named Fred, and her
 children to wit: James a male about sixteen
 Jefferson a male about ten yellow and me-
 rdy about seven years old a female Murt a
 male about three years old black also baradin
 a female about nine months old the right
 and title of said negroes for the consideration
 of sixteen hundred dollars to me in hand
 paid I do hereby warrant and forever defend
 against myself, my heirs, executors and ex-
 ecutrix, administrators and all and every per-
 son or persons unto the said Thos. P. Hawkins
 and his heirs and executors forever,
 In witness whereof I have set my hand
 and fixed my seal.
