To Shelly County made and entered  
David Owen unto bellivers James W Smith of the one part  
Page 213. and David Owen of the other part,  
Witnesseth what for and in consideration

of the sum of twelve hundred and fifty Dollars  
 in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged hath granted, bargained and  
 sold and by these presents doth grant bargain  
 and sell unto the said David Owen his heirs  
 and assigns all that certain tract or parcel  
 of land lying and being in the County of  
 Shelby discribed as follows; to wit; the East  
 half of the North West quarter of section twenty  
 five Township twenty one and Range west  
 also the west half of the North West quarter  
 of section twenty five in Township and range  
 as of the first also the west half of the South  
 West quarter of section twenty five Township  
 and range as above also the land in the East  
 half of the North East quarter of section twenty  
 six same Township and range as above,  
 lying East of the town of Columbia and  
 South of the street running directly east from  
 where the Court house of Shelby County now  
 stand, to have and to hold the above described  
 lands, with the appurtenances thereto be-  
 longing to the said David Owen his heirs and  
 assigns forever against me my heirs or any  
 other person whatsoever. In witness whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29<sup>th</sup>

 or claim to come to the within described

tract of land to the said David Owen his
