Shelby County, presents shall come  
gathering, whereas at the last term of  
the Circuit Court of Shelby County  
began and held in the town of Colum-  
bia on the fifth Monday after the  
fourth Monday in March last the  
Honorable Anderson Crenshaw presiding  
as Chancellor named a decree against  
the Administrator and guardians of the  
Estate and infant heirs of Samuel Ham-  
kins deceased requiring the said Ad-  
ministrator and guardians as aforesaid  
to make titles to the land named in said

done. Now know ye that I Thomas H. Brasher  
 Administrator of Samuel Hawkins and  
 Guardian of their infant heirs in pursuance  
 of said decree do hereby transfer all the title  
 intent & claim that the said Samuel Hawkins  
 had at the time of his death and since to the  
 following described land to wit: East half of  
 the South East quarter of section No. 3 in  
 township no. twenty one, and range no.  
 one East containing twenty nine  $\frac{8}{100}$  of an  
 acre, to Ambrose Dollar his heirs & assigns for-  
 ever unto all and singular the hereditaments  
 and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
 anywise appertaining and wholly vest in  
 the said Ambrose Dollar all the intent either  
 in law or equity which the said Samuel  
 Hawkins had to the above described land  
 in testimony whereof I have set my hand  
 and seal this twenty first day of March  
 1832,

 in the presence of the said Thos. H. Brasher and  
 that he saw Thos. Jolley one of the other sub-  
 scriber witness sign the same in the presence  
 of the said Thos. H. Brasher and in the presence  
 of the other one the day and year herein men-  
 tioned, given under my hand and seal this 18<sup>th</sup>  
 day of February, 1833.
