

Robertson & B., This Indenture made and entered into
the second day of March A.D. 1833 between
William Condon and Henry B. Robertson
his wife, of the first part, of the State of
Alabama and County of Shelby and
William Condon of the County and State
aforesaid of the second part, Wilmouth,
that the said Henry & Betsy his wife for
and in consideration of the sum of one
thousand dollars, to us in hand paid by
the said William Condon, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged before the sealing
and delivering of these presents hereto
granted, bargained, sold and aliened and
by these presents do grant, bargain sell
and deliver unto the said William
Condon his heirs & executors a certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being

in the County and State aforesaid, known
and described as follows; to wit, being the West
half of the North West quarter of section thirteen
township twenty one range one East, containing
twenty nine acres and $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre, also the
East half of the North East quarter of section
thirteen, township twenty one range one East
containing twenty nine acres and $\frac{1}{4}$ of an
acre, also the East half of the South West
quarter of section twelve township twenty
one, of range one East containing twenty nine
acres, and $\frac{1}{4}$ hundredths of an acre, all
in the district of Tuscaloosa and State of Ala-
bama, to have and to hold the said land &
premises hereby conveyed with all the appur-
tenances thereto belonging or in anywise ap-
pertaining until the said William Gordon
his heirs & and to be free from no one his
executors and assigns and from all other
claim or claims of all and every other per-
son or persons claiming through or under
the same, either in law or equity,
