

Jones and This Indenture made this 24th day of April
do in the year of our Lord one thousand and six
hundred and thirty three, between James
S. Bryant and Jones of the County of Shropshire and stale
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of Alabama, of the one part and Silas G. Byram
 of the County and State aforesaid of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Ann Jones in consideration of Five hundred dollars in hand paid by
 the said Silas G. Byram the receipt whereof he
 doth hereby acknowledge hath granted has and
 sold released and confirms and by these presents
 doth grant, bargain and release and confirm
 unto the said Silas G. Byram his heirs & assigns
 forever, all the East half of Section West quarter
 of section thirty two of Township thirteen
 range one East in the district of Huntsville and
 and State of Alabama in the County of Blount
 lying on the Little River containing eighty
 acres, with all and singular the hereditaments
 and appurtenances whatsoever to the same be-
 longing or appertaining and the revenues or re-
 revenue, remains & remainders next rents &
 profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof
 & also all estate right title and interest, first fruits
 claims & demand whatsoever both at law and in
 equity of the said Ann Jones in or out of the
 said lands, timber etc, hereditaments or pre-
 mises to have and to hold the said land his
 mentioned with their appurtenances unto the
 said Silas G. Byram his heirs & assigns & to his
 and their only proper use and behoef, and
 the said Ann Jones doth hereby for herself
 her heirs, executors & administrators, covenant
 promise & agree to and with the said Silas G.
 Byram his heirs, executors, administrators &
 assigns in manner and form following, that
 is to say that the said Silas G. Byram his heirs
 and assigns shall and may peaceably and
 quietly have hold and every part and parcel
 thereof without let, suit trouble eviction
 or disturbance of the said Ann Jones her heirs
 or assigns other person or persons lawfully
 claiming or to claim formerly or under or
 trust from him them or any of them and
 that the said lands, timber etc hereditaments
 and premises and every part and parcel thereof
 more all and from hence forth shall continue
 remain and be unto the said Silas G.
 Byram his heirs & assigns free from all
 clear and freely and clearly acquitt'd

executed and discharged of, from against
all former and other gifts, grants, bargains
sales, mortgages, etc., till charges and
membranes relations, had made done
committed occasioned or suffered by the said
Ann Jones or by any person lawfully
claiming or his claim by force or under
him or by his direction or any of their acts
means against or procured and the said
Ann Jones her heirs all and assigns the
aforesaid land timber cuts, hereditaments
and possessions and every part and parcel
thereof unto the said Silas G. Biggs or his
heirs, & assigns against her the said Ann
Jones, her heirs & assigns shall and will
warrant and forever defend by these pres-
ents In witness whereof I have set my
hand & seal the day & date above written
and in the fifty ninth year of the Inde-
pendence of the United States.
