present do bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and
convey unto the said Rachel Hays and the
heirs of her body or assigns a certain par-
cel of land all that tract of land lying
on the north West side of the East fork
of Cahaba, it being a part of the East half
of the South West quarter of section thirty
township seventeen range one East run-
ning from the head of the creek near
the lime kilns crossing the State road
to the open road supposed to be sixty acres
more or less, it being in the district of
Innisavas and State of Alabama to have
and to hold the above described tract of
land with the improvements and appurtenances
thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
unto the said Rachel Hays and heirs of her body
forever and the said William Cameron do forever
warrant and defend unto the said Rachel
Hays and the heirs of her body do forever war-
rant and defend the title to the above descri-
bed and hereby granted premises unto the said
Rachel Hays and the heirs of her body from
me my heirs and assigns and all and every
person or persons claiming or holding under
my claim to the said premises and land
above described and also against the lawful
title, claim or demand of all and every person
or persons whomsoever, claiming or holding
by from or under the government of the
United States in the territory whereof
the said William Cameron tract hereto set
his hand & seal the day & year above written.
