

Steele John State of Alabama / This Indenture made and
 To Shelly County entered into this 30th day of
 Benj Johnson July 1832 between John Steele of the first part &
 Page 206 of Debtor I & S. Brasher the second part, and
 Benj Johnson the trustee of the third part, Whereas
 the said John Steele is greatly indebted to said S.
 S. Brasher in the sum of sixty five Dollars and
 is willing and desirous of securing the same,
 Now this indenture witnesseth that in consider-
 ation of the promise and also for the further con-
 sideration of one dollar in hand paid the
 said John Steele by said Benjamin Johnson
 the Trustee at and before the sealing and deliver-
 ing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged he the said John Steele hath given,
 granted, bargained & sold and by these presents doth
 give, grant, bargain & sell to said Benjamin
 Johnson, his heirs and assigns forever the follow-
 ing property to wit: one mare & colt and four
 cows, and calves, 10 head of two year old hogs &
 14 pigs & 1 Lown bed, & furniture the said John
 Steele will forever defend and doth main-
 tain further witnesseth that if the said John
 Steele shall make default in payment of
 sum of Sixty five Dollars by 25th December
 1834, with legal interest thereon from this date
 then and in that case the said Benjamin
 Johnson shall when requested by S. S. Brasher
 sell at public Auction in the Town of Columbia
 all or so much of said property as shall be suffi-
 cient to satisfy the said sum of sixty ^{and} ~~one~~ dollars
 with interest thereon together with all incor-
 porated expenses after leaving given fifteen
 days notice at the Court house door in Shelly
 County, by endorsement sell the said the said
 property for ready money and pay said debt
 and if any remain after satisfying the said
 debt, and expenses, shall pay the same to the
 said John Steele. In witness whereof the parties
 have set their hand & seal this 30th day of

July 1832, and renewed 17th September, 1833.
