 M. Nabors are held and firmly bound unto
 John Castle Governor of the State of Alabama
 for the sum being and his successors in office
 in the penal sum of three thousand dollars
 to the true payment whereof well and truly
 to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and
 severally and joint and several heirs ex-
 ecutors and administrators firmly by these
 presents sealed with our seals and dated the
 third day of Oct. 1833. The condition of the
 above obligation is such that whereas the
 above bounden Archibald Sloan at the August
 election 1833 was duly elected assessor and
 tax collector for said County of Shelley for the
 year eighteen hundred and thirty four.
 Now if the said Archibald Sloan shall well
 and truly and faithfully perform the duties
 required of him while in office, then the
 above obligation to be void, else remain
