The State of Alabama, Shelby County,
Know all men by these presents that we
Archibald Sloan, Thomas J. Walker
and Daniel C. Waterson are held and firmly
bound unto John Bassett Gayle governor of
the State of Alabama and his successors in
office in the sum of Three thousand
Dollars for the payment of which we
truly to be made we bind our selves our
heirs & jointy & severally and formerly
sealed with our seals and dated this 2nd
day of December A. D. 1833. The condition
of the above obligation is such that whereas
the above bounden Archibald Sloan was
duly elected at the first election 1834
assessor and Tax collector for Shelby Co
to assess and collect the taxes for the year

1935 in said County, now if the said Archibald Sloan shall well and truly do & perform all the duties which hereafter may be required of him as such assessor and Tax Collector and pay over to the proper authority all moneys as may be by law required of him so as such assess and Tax Collectors that the above obligations to be void shal remain in full force & effect.
