to Shelley Lascbury. Said entered into this
Ruben Borden 25th day of January 1839 between Robert
Page 237. Gardner of the first part and Ruben Borden
of the second part. This Indenture witnesseth
that the said party of the first part for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred and
fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by the
said party of the second part to receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged and facts granted has
grained, hold and by these present doth grant

bargains & sell unto the said party of the record part, and to his heirs & assigns the following described tract of land &c wit:-
 the West half of the North East quarter or section
 twelve in township twenty four of Range fifteen
 East in the District of Tuscaloosa, con-
 taining eighty acres, be the same more or
 less, together with all and singular the
 hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining
 to have and to hold to him the said party
 of the record part & his heirs & assigns forever
 with all the estate, right title and interest
 to the above bargained premises to the sole and
 only proper use and benefit & behoof of the
 said party of the record part either in law
 or in equity. In witness whereof the said
 party hath set his hand & affixed his seal
 the day & date before written.
