sold, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and confirm unto the said John M^r Lead
his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of
land lying and being in the County of
Shelby, Alabama, known and designated
as the East half of the North West quarter
of Section two, in Township twenty one of
Range one East in the district of Tuscaloosa

Ala. containing eighty acres, and twenty two hundredths of an acre, be the same more or less, together with all and singular the premises, with the appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the lands thereby conveyed with the appurtenances unto the said John McLeod his heirs & assigns forever. And the said John Brasher and Elizabeth his wife for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators the aforesaid tract or land & premises unto the said John McLeod his heirs & assigns against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever, do and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
