 That the said party of the first part for and in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred and
 forty dollars to him in hand paid by the
 said party of the second part the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained
 sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and
 confirms unto the said party of the second
 part, to his heirs and assigns the following
 described tract of land & premises, the South
 West quarter of the S8 $\frac{1}{4}$ section No. 29 township
 No. 21 Range no. 1 east containing forty $10\frac{1}{2}$
 acres, be the same more or less, in the district
 of Tuscaloosa, together with all and singular
 the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto
 belonging, or in any wise appertaining to have
 and to hold to him the said party of the second
 part his heirs & assigns forever, with all the
 estate, title and interest to the above bargaining
 premises to the sole and only proper use benefit
 a behalf of the said party of the second part
 either in law or in equity. In witness
 whereof the said party of the first part hath
 signed at his name and affixed his seal
 this day & year before witnesses
