Edmund King of Shelly County, State of  
Alabama, and held and by due present  
firmly bound unto William Baker in  
the sum of two thousand dollars  
for the faithful performance or payment  
of which, well and truly to be made &  
done I bind myself my heirs & assigns  
firmly by these presents. On witness whereof  
I recollect set my hand & seal this 21st  
day of November 1832, The consideration of  
the above obligation is such that whereas  
the above bounden Edmund King taught this  
day sold to the said William Baker the  
E<sup>1/4</sup> of the N E<sup>1/4</sup> of section no. 23, township  
no. 21 of Range one west also the E<sup>1/4</sup> of the  
N E<sup>1/4</sup> of section no. 26, township no 21  
of Range one west, with the reservation of  
what is contained in all the lots laid off  
for the towns of Columbian & other lots  
adjoining streets which have already been  
sold, also all that lies the east side of  
said town square and south of the road  
leading from Wilcoxville William Baker  
to Ryndulay reserving also the unexpired  
term of the lease made by Smith & Young  
to have and to hold the above described tracts  
of land with the appurtenances thereunto  
belonging, for the payment of which the  
said Baker hath ex ceed to the said  
King his promissory note for one hun-  
dred dollars due the 1st day of January  
next, also another note for five hundred

eighteen dollars due the first day of January  
1834, or the payment of which notes the  
said King obligates himself as above to ex-  
cite to the said William Baker his heirs  
or assigns a good warranted bill to the afore-  
said described tract of land thru this obliga-  
tion to be null & void, otherwise to be and  
remain in full force & virtue.
