

Pawyer vs. Bullock. This indenture made the 16th day of September
in the year of our Lord 1833 between Amel
Bullock, Pawyer of the County of Talladega - State of
Page 25^o. Alabama, of the first part, and Brumley &c.

Bullcock of the County of Shelby and State
 aforesaid of the second part, witnesseth that
 the said party of the first part, for and in
 consideration of the sum of one dollar in
 hand paid by the said party of the second
 part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged that hath bargained and sold and by
 these presents doth bargain and sell unto
 the said party of the second part, and to his
 heirs or assigns forever the mill seat and
 mill at and upon the three Island Shallows
 on Coosa River in the County of Shelby and
 State aforesaid together with all and singular
 the hereditaments and appurtenances there-
 unto belonging or in anywise appertaining
 and the revenue and revenues, remainder
 and remains due unto him and profits
 thereof, and also are the estate, right, title
 intent, claim or demand whatsoever of
 him the said party of the first part either
 in law or equity of in aid to the above
 bargained premises and every part and
 parcel thereof to have and to hold to the said
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 to the sole and only proper use and benefit
 and behoof of the said party of the second
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto
