The State of Alabama, I Aug. 23d 1833, know  
Shelby County. I all may by these presents  
that I Jonathan Clover of the state and County  
aforesaid in consideration of the natural love &  
affection which I bear to Jonathan S. Clover  
of the said State and County aforesaid as well  
as for the further consideration of one dollar to me  
in hand paid by the said Jonathan S. Clover  
at or before the sealing & delivering of these presents  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have  
given and granted, and by these presents do  
give and grant unto the said Jonathan S.  
Clover his executors, administrators or assigns  
forty acres of land, one wagon & two horses, one  
set of Smith's tools, one bed and furniture, five  
head of cattle, ten head of hogs, one bible, eleven  
volumes of magazines & volumes of Works  
works, to have and to hold the said property  
unto him the said Jonathan S. Clover his  
executors, administrators & assigns forever  
and the said Jonathan Clover for himself  
his executors and assigns the said property  
unto the said Jonathan S. Clover his executors  
administrators and assigns against the claim  
of him the said Jonathan S. Clover his execu-  
tors and administrators, and against the claim  
or claims of all and every person or persons  
whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever  
defend them by these presents. In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
