 this day of November in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and six
 between Lewis Dunn of the first part and John
 McLeod of the second part, witnesseth that
 the said party of the first part for and in
 consideration of the sum of one thousand
 dollars to him in hand paid by the said
 party of the second part the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged tract granted bargained
 and sold and all unto the said party of the
 second part his heirs & assigns forever the follow-
 ing described tracts or parcels of land to wit
 the South East fractions of section twenty three
 in township twenty one of Range one East
 in the district of Tuscaloosa and state of Alabama
 containing one hundred and fifty two acres
 and sixty four hundredths of an acre, also
 the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ section no. twenty three town-
 ship no twenty one Range no one East containing
 thirty nine $\frac{9}{100}$ acres, and also the NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
 NW $\frac{1}{4}$ section no. 26 township no. 21 Range no.
 East containing forty acres, together with all and
 singular the hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
 to the same to have and to hold to the said
 party of the second part his heirs & assigns
 and the survivor and successors, remainder
 and remainders, rents issues and profits and
 also all the right, title, intent claim or de-
 mand, notwithstanding to him the said party
 of the first part either in law or equity of law
 and to the before bargained premises and
 every tract and parcel thereof to have and
 hold to him the said party of the second
 his heirs & assigns forever to the sole and
 only proper use of him the said party of
 the second part his heirs & assigns.
