 Township twenty range three West in the
 district of Tuscaloosa together with all and
 singular the rights and privileges thereto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining
 hereto with all the words, ways, rents
 issues, profits thereto appertaining hereto
 as fully as the grant of the United States
 has made and granted unto Edmund King
 agreed by the Patent and from the said
 King to Julius Read, and from the
 Read to Agnes Farrell, and from the
 said Agnes Farrell to the above named
 persons, and now by them to Eli Cort,

his heirs and assigns forever, and we Richard
Cawson, John D. Brown, James H. Cawson
Jane Eliza Sneed, Charles Anderson, Mary S.
Cawson, Martha Penilia Cawson, Sarah Car-
oline Cawson and William R. Cawson we
do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, assigns
and successors do warrant and forever defend
the above described land to Eli Cat his heirs
assigns forever, clear from the claim or
claims of any person or persons, claiming
the same or any part thereof. We sign under
our hands or seals this tenth day of March
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty four.

The State of Alabama. Personally appeared
Shelby County before me William
M. Johnson, Clerk of the Circuit Court of
said County Elizabeth Cawson and ac-
knowledged that she signed, sealed and
delivered the above relinquishment of power
to Eli Cat for the purpose therein specified
and being examined privately separately and
apart from her said husband acknowl-
edged that she did the same freely and other-
wise accorded without any fear, threats or
compulsion on the part of her said husband.
