to Cross of Shelby County & State of Alabama,  
Andrew J. Cross for and in consideration of the natural love  
Page 280 and affection which I bear to my son  
Andrew J. Cross; as well as for the further

considerations of one dollar to me in hand  
 paid by the said Andrew J. Cross before  
 the sealing and delivering of these presents  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 hath given and granted, and by these pres-  
 ents do give & grant unto the said Andrew  
 J. Cross his executors and administrators  
 and assigns a certain mulatto girl named  
 Priscilla aged ten years to have and to hold  
 the said Mulatto girl until her death  
 said Andrew J. Cross his executors ad-  
 ministrators and assigns forever. And the  
 said William Cross for himself his ex-  
 ecutors and administrators the said mulatto  
 girl until the said Andrew J. Cross his ex-  
 ecutors and administrators and assigns  
 against the claim of him the said William  
 Cross and all other persons whatsoever  
 shall and will warrant and forever defend  
 by these presents. In testimony whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed  
 my seal this 3d day of March 1835.  
 Sealed & delivered in presence of William Cross <sup>in</sup>  
 of Hazare Littlefield & shos: Heath. <sup>March</sup>  
 The State of Alabama. Personally appeared  
 Shelly County. Before me William  
 Cross James Wardruff Judge of the County  
 Court of Shelly County William Cross and  
 acknowledged that he signed sealed & delivered  
 possession of the property named in the  
 foregoing deed Bill of sale on the date above  
 mentioned given under my hand & seal  
 this 17th day of March 1835.
