 and sold and by these presents do grant bar-
 gain, release & confirm unto Alphonso A. Sterrett
 the following described tracts or parcels of land
 lying and being in Shelby County & Tuscaloosa
 (and district) being one hundred & sixty $\frac{40}{100}$
 acres, more or less viz: the West half of the North
 West quarter of section twenty six in township
 twenty one of Range one west, and the East half
 of the South East quarter of section twenty six
 of township twenty one of range one west
 together with all and singular the premises
 with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining to have and to hold the said
 land & premises with the appurtenances unto the
 said Alphonso A. Sterrett his heirs and assigns
 forever. And the said James V. M^cGraw and
 Harriett H. M^cGraw his wife for themselves
 their heirs executors & administrators the offspring
 tracts of land & premises unto the said Alphonso
 A. Sterrett his heirs or assigns do & will forever
 defend by these presents. In testimony whereof
