ginning along Montgumery road. I have
and to hold the afore granted premises to
the said Sturutt his heirs & assigns to them
over me and behoof forever. And I do cov-
enant with the said Sturutt his heirs and
assigns that I am lawfully seized of the
afore granted premises, that they are free of
all incumbrances, that I have a good
right to sell and convey the same to the
said Sturutt, his heirs & assigns, and that
I will warrant and defend the said
premises to the said Sturutt his heirs &
assigns forever, against the lawful claim
or demands of all persons.
