presents shall be void but if any or
either of said notes are not punctually paid
it shall be lawful for the president of said
Branch Bank to seize and sell said ne-
groes Jobe and Danner at public auction
at such time and place as he may think
proper giving ten days notice of the same
by advertisement in some paper pub-
lished in said State and applying the
proceeds of said sale to the payment of
said notes or either of them whether the
same are due or not with all interest
damages and costs as well of the sale
as upon the notes and the said David
Owen doth hereby for himself his heirs
and assigns warrant and agree to de-
fend the title made on such sale against
all persons - Witness my hand and
