Witnesseth - That the said Henry James Woodruff for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained sold & conveyed unto the said Henry Harless his heirs & assigns the following land To wit: The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section no. 36 Township no. 21 of Range no. 3 West in the District of land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, To have and to hold to the said Henry Harless his heirs & assigns the above described lands, Together with all the rights, members and appurtenances thereunto belonging And the said James Woodruff for himself his heirs, executors, administrators or do forever defend the right title & interest to the said Henry Harless his heirs & assigns & from all & every other person or persons whatsoever - In Testimony I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day & date above written - James Woodruff (Seal)
