McBlanchard of the 2<sup>d</sup> part, witnesseth that said Ellerson for and in consideration of fifty five Dollars to him in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has given, granted, bargained and sold to said McBlanchard the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section no. 19 Township no. 24 Range 14 E. To have and to hold said land and premises with the appurtenances forever & the said Ellerson will forever warrant & defend titles to the same - Witness my hand and seal this 8 January 1843.

To have and to hold the said property to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said Robert Bowdon, his heirs &c forever - This conveyance is made upon this expressed condition ~~that~~ that if the said William G. Bowdon shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Robert Bowdon on or before the first day of January next the sum of twenty four hundred dollars one half due the first day of January last the other half due the first day of January next then this conveyance to be void else to remain in full force - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this third day of April 1843.
