in the State of Alabama of the one part & Daniel & Horton of the other part witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred & twenty Dollars to them in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained sold aliened enoffed & conveyed & by these presents do bargain sell enoff & convey to the said party of the 2^d part all that tract or piece of land lying and being in the County & State aforesaid & are as follows to wit the South half of the North East fourth of Section No 10 Township Twenty Two Range one West to have & to hold the above described Land & premises with the Tenements & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said party of the second part his heirs & assigns forever & the said party of the first part for their heirs Executors & Administrators do warrant & will forever defend the title to the above described Land & hereby granted premises unto the said party of the 2^d part his heirs & assigns present & against us the said party of the first part & all and every person or persons claiming or holding under us the said party of the first part and also against the Lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming or holding by grant or under the Government of the United States Intest many whereof the said party of the first part have hereunto set their hands & seals the day and year above written
