bargain & sell unto the said John Mink and to his -
heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land
lying & being in the county of Shelly & State of Alabama
described as all that part of the West half of
South East fourth of section three Township Twenty
two of Range three West that lies on the North side of
Shack Creek also all that part of the East half of the
South West fourth of said section that lies on the
North side of said Creek also all that part of the West
half of the South West fourth of said section Township
and Range that lies the East side of an other branch
of said Creek that runs by Henry Ditts & adjoining lands
of Jeremiah Sawley & supposed to continue in all the above
described piece of Land about one hundred & twenty acres
more or less to have & to hold the above granted or in -
tended to be granted premises & appurtenances therunto
belonging to him the said John Mink his heirs and
assigns forever & to their own benefit & behoof and
we the said Edmond & Susan D King wife of the said
Edmond King for ourselves our heirs Executors Administrators
and assigns do covenant to & with the said John
Mink his heirs and Executors Administrators & assigns that at
and until the Ensealing of these presents we Lawfully
Seized of the premises & have a Good right to bargain
& sell the same are free from all encumbrances whatsoever
and that we do hereby covenant and agree with the said
John Mink his heirs & assigns that they may and shall
quietly Enjoy the same without the least hindrance
from us the said Edmond King or any person or persons
claiming under us and that the Lands & premises shall
be & remain unto the said John Mink for & clear of
all former Gifts Grants conveyances or Encumbrances -
whosoever & that the said Edmond wife of the said
Edmond King for themselves their heirs Executors -
Administrators & assigns will warrant & forever defend
the said Lands unto the said John Mink his heirs
& assigns forever against us the said Edmond King
& Susan D King wife of said Edmond King & all
claiming under us In testimony whereof we have hereunto set
our hands & seals this the 7th day of May 1847
