 Mortgage to This indenture made this 29th day of January
 1847 between Elisha Lawley of said county & state
 of the first part and Daniel W. Prutice of the said county
 & state of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said
 Elisha Lawley in & by a certain promissory note bearing date
 29th Day of January A. D. 1847 for the sum of forty Eight $22\frac{1}{100}$
 and payable by the first day of December next thereafter
 then ensuing as in the said promissory note recitation hereunto
 being had more fully and at Large appears now this indenture
 Witnesseth that the said Elisha Lawley as well for & in consider-
 =ation of the aforesaid debt of forty Eight $22\frac{1}{100}$ Dollars and
 the better securing thereof unto the said Daniel W. Prutice
 his Executors Administrators and assigns as of the further sum
 of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the said Prutice
 at and before the sealing & delivering hereof the receipt -
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath Granted bargain -
 released & sold & by these presents with Grant bargain release
 And sell unto the said Daniel W. Prutice his heirs & assigns -
 forever all right title & interest which he the said Elisha Lawley
 has in or to the following property to wit one square more with
 a slave face supposed to be about or between twelve & fifteen
 years old called Blage by name two sows & ten pigs
 one of the sows about three years old which sow has six pigs
 about two months old the other sow about one year old
 with four pigs about two months old and one spotted -
 sow about fourteen or fifteen months old all of which property
 the said Prutice shall see by giving ten days notice by
 advertisement on the premises of said Lawley to the highest
 bidder for cash & out of the proceeds arising from such -
 sale pay & satisfy said note of forty Eight $22\frac{1}{100}$ Dollars
 & all cost that may accrue thereon that is for recording this
 deed of trust &c & the effect if any pay to the Lawley provided
 always never the less if the said E. Lawley his heirs Executors
 or administrators shall & do well & truly pay or cause to be
 paid to the said Daniel W. Prutice his Executors Administrators
 or assigns the aforesaid note of forty Eight $22\frac{1}{100}$ Dollars
 on or by the time when the same shall due and payable
 without any grace or further delay or without any
 deduction defalcation or abatement then & from thence
 = forth as well this present indenture & the property above
 conveyed as also the said promissory note shall cease
 determine & become absolutely void all interest & purposes
 any thing herein contained before to the contrary notwithstanding
 standing otherwise to remain in full force & effect
