 for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred
 Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Ben-
 -jah Wilks the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have bargained and sold and by these presents
 doth bargain and sell unto the said Benajah -
 Wilks a certain tract or parcel of land lying and
 being in the County of Tallapoosa and designated &
 known as the East half of Section Two in Township
 Twenty four of Range No Twenty and in the Coosa
 land district together with all and singular the
 rights improvements & appurtenances to said
 land belonging to him the said Wilks his heirs
 and assigns forever to have and to hold the said
 above described land the tenements & hereditaments
 & appurtenances or unto said party of the second
 part his heirs & assigns to them and by their use
 benefit & behoof forever and the said party of the
 first part doth Covenant to and with the party
 of the second part that he is well seized and
 possessed of said premises and that he has good
 title in fee simple and full perfect right to bar-
 -gain and sell and doth further warrant and
 defend the title of said premises to the said party
 of the second part his heirs and assigns against
 all persons whatsoever In testimony whereof now
 the said party of the first part have hereunto set
 our hands & affixed our seals the day and year
 above written
