& truly pay or cause to be paid to the said party
of the third part the amount of said note with
lawful interest thereon then this deed is to be
void and of no effect but if the said party of
of the first part shall make default in the payment
of said sum of money in said note mentioned
or any part thereof then the said party of the
second part may & upon the requisition of the said
party of the third part shall proceed to take
possession of the said bargained property & after
giving ten days in writing on the Court house door in
Columbiana shall then sell the same to the

highest bidder & after paying said debts interest & all
 necessary costs if any of the proceeds of said sale remains
