 following described property to wit the South East fourth of
 North East fourth Section Twenty and also South East

 West fourth & North West fourth of South West fourth
 and also South West fourth of South West fourth
 of Section twenty two and all in Township Twenty four
 Range Thirteen East (except one forty acres claimed
 by said Watson as a homestead under the Homestead Law
 of this state to have & to hold said bargained property
 or premises unto him the said Edmund King his heirs
 and assigns forever & the said Thomas H. Brashear
 Sherriff as aforesaid do so far as the Office of Sherriff
 authorizes me hereby warrant said property or real estate
 unto him the said Edmund King his heirs & assigns &
 the same to have hold use & enjoy in the same manner
 the aforesaid Alexander Watson Defendants as aforesaid
 could or might have held & enjoyed said property had
 not the same been seized and sold by virtue of the writ.
