 William H Crawford 1847 Whereas James McCollum of
 the first part and William H Crawford of the 2^d part
 Witnesseth that whereas James McCollum of the first
 part is indebted to William H Crawford on a promissory
 note for ninety six and seventy hundredths of a dollar
 due the 25th of December next & in order that the said
 McCollum may fully protect said William H Crawford
 from any loss and fully secure him as aforesaid as well
 as far and in consideration of one dollar to me in hand
 paid by the said William H Crawford the said James
 McCollum has given granted bargained & sold and by
 these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto
 the said William H Crawford an set of Black
 Smith Cook Two Cows & Calves one ~~hopper~~ grating one
 Bed and furniture one mettle block one safe one
 Man and Cattle to hand and to hold said property
 to the said Crawford and his heirs forever upon trust
 nevertheless and it is hereby expressly agreed & understood
 that the said McCollum is to retain possession of said
 property until the payment of the aforesaid sum of
 money his to be made then the said Crawford at once
 seize said property and take the same into his
 possession and proceed to sell the same to the highest
 bidder for cash first giving twenty days notice in at
 least three public places of the time and place
 of said sale and out of said sale pay the said debt
 beyond enumerated as well the expenses of this deed
 of trust and the balance of any pay over to the
 said McCollum but should the whole debt be
 paid fully without injury or loss to the said Crawford
 then this deed of to be null and void and of no
 effect in testimony of I have this day set my hand
 and seal this 28th day of October A.D. 1847
