 of the North West fourth Section twenty six in Township  
 twenty one of Range three West containing forty acres more or  
 less in the district of subjects to sale at New Castle Alabama  
 together with all and singular the rights members and  
 appurtenances therunto belonging of the above described land  
 to the said John Gaunt his heirs and assigns to the only  
 proper benefit and behoof of farmers in fee simple and the  
 said Miles G. Gaunt & Martha will forever warrant & defend  
 the right and title of the above described land to the said  
 John Gaunt his heirs &c from them selves their heirs  
 Executors and administrators and from all and every other  
 person whatsoever intestate or otherwise who of us have herunto  
 set our hands and seals this day and year above  
 written
