 the one part and Henry D & Harlep of the County and State
 aforesaid of the other parts Witnesseth that the said Henry
 Harlep and Margaret Harlep his for and in consideration of
 the sum of four hundred & fifty dollars to them in hand
 paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both
 this day bargained and sold and by these presents doth
 bargain sell & convey unto the said Henry D & Harlep all
 all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
 County of Shelby and State aforesaid and known as the
 East half of the South West quarter of Section Twenty
 four also the South West fourth of South East fourth
 of Section Twenty four, all Township Twenty one Range
 Three West containing one hundred and twenty acres -
 more or less in the District of Land subject to sale at
 Greencross Alabama together with all and singular
 incidents and rights in any wise appertaining
 thunto to the said H D & Harlep his heirs and assigns
 for ever and that the Henry & Margaret Harlep
 for themselves their heirs Executors & administrators doth
 warrant and will ever defend the right & title to the
 above described and hereby conveyed premises unto the
 said H D & Harlep his heirs and assigns for ever and against
 the claims of them the said Henry and Margaret Harlep
 and all and every person or persons claiming or holding
 under by the said Henry Harlep and Margaret Harlep
 his wife and also against the Lawful title claim
 or demand of all and every person or persons whomsoever
 claiming or holding by or from the General Government
 of the United States of America
 Intentionally whereof we the said Henry and Margaret
 Harlep have hereunto set our hands and seals this day
 year above written
